All adult helpers/volunteers who help at the Gala from months before the event through that evening, will need to purchase a Gala ticket for \$40 each (that price until March 18th) to include entrance to the event, one dinner per ticket, attending the Auction Preview the week before the Gala, and the social fun or chance to bid when not working. Most of these week/evening-of jobs are for about three hours (except the Dinner & other Committees which is a longer time) so there wille time to socialize or bid on auction items.
