Grain Auction Committee Responsibilities

- Grain Auction Chairmen contact Hartington Feed & Chick & Fordyce Coop before harvest to arrange the grain storage. Ask the elevators to put up their Gala grain posters.
- Grain Auction Committee solicitation lists are sent in the early fall. Contact all on your list every year. Turn into
 the Development Office any changes or additions to your lists. It's important that you help keep lists updated
 every year.
- Contact all possible grain donors during the harvest season. All grain donations will need to be confirmed at the elevators. The updated lists, grain gifts, and donors will come from the Fordyce Coop or Hartington Feed & Chick for publication. Confirm all grain donors by February 3, 2025 to be listed in the Gala book and Newspaper ads.
- Grain Chairmen will convert all other grain and/or cash donations to corn by Wednesday, March 26, 2025. Check with Joani at the Development Office for totals.
- Grain Auction Chairmen will be on stage with Auctioneers to assist and record bushels sold during the Grain Auction. Fill out Grain Certificates and distribute to grain buyers Check with Joani after the Gala to make arrangement fo where to pick up your corn.
